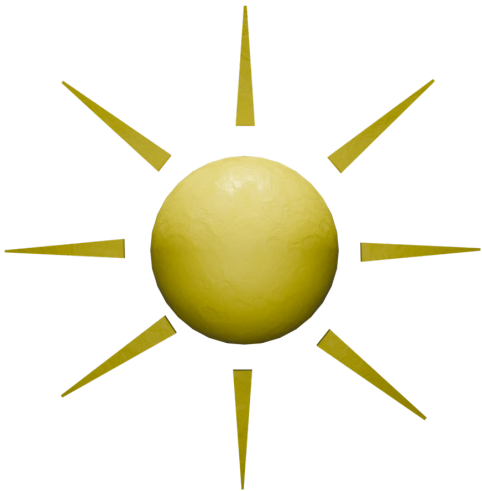




Dyffryn Dyfodol (Future Valleys) Project Review

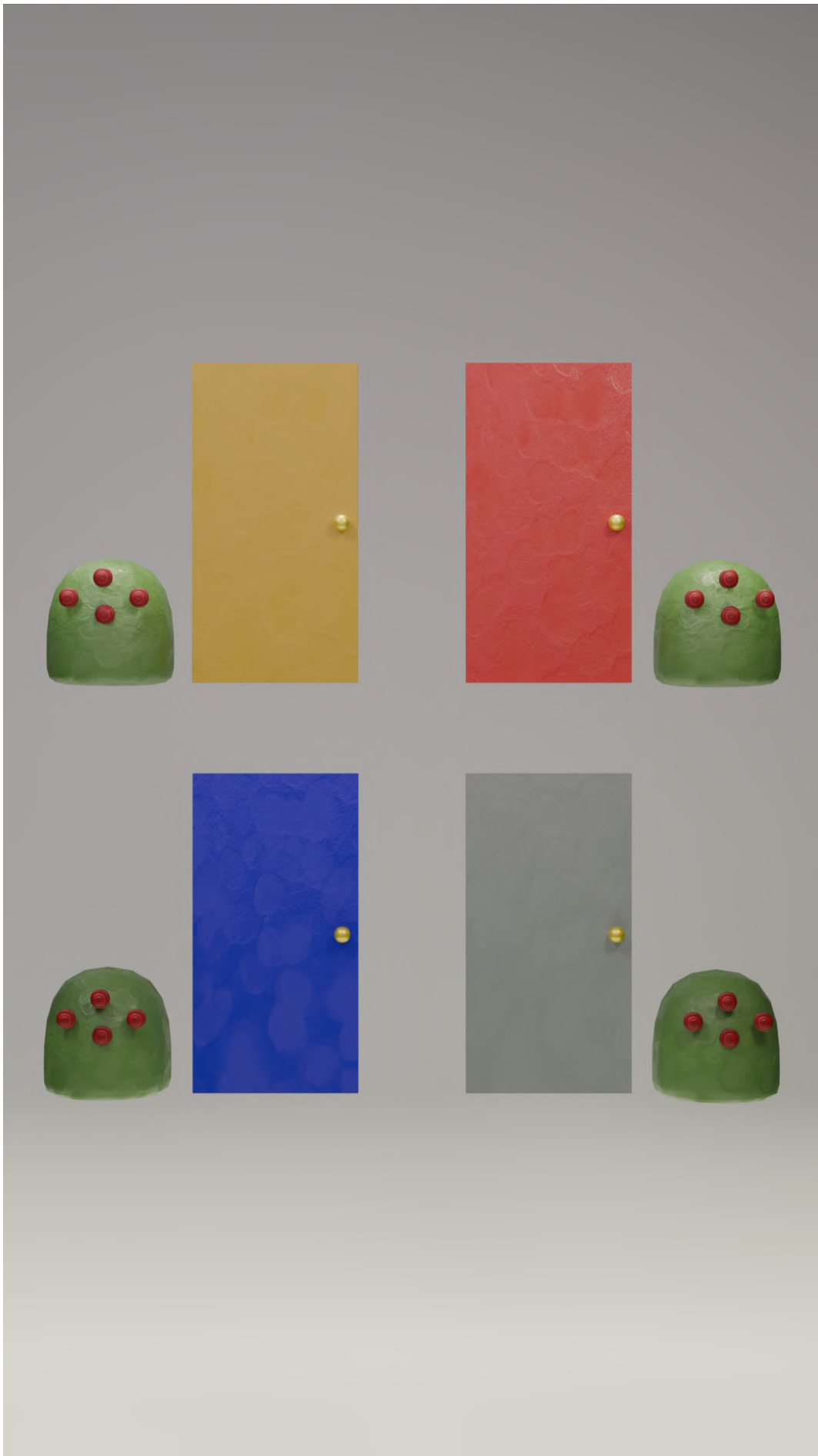
I adapted this same willingness within my own work after hearing Iwan and Katie say:
